This course studies God's Word as it has been expressed and handed on in Sacred Scripture and Sacred Tradition with a special focus on the central teachings of the Catholic faith (such as creation, the fall and redemption, the Trinity and Incarnation, the Church and the Holy Spirit). Emphasis is placed on reading biblical texts, understood in light of writings of the Church Doctors and Fathers, major theologians, Magisterial documents and texts in the Franciscan tradition.



This **tuition-based** course will be a blended class offered online instruction with only three on-campus classes required.

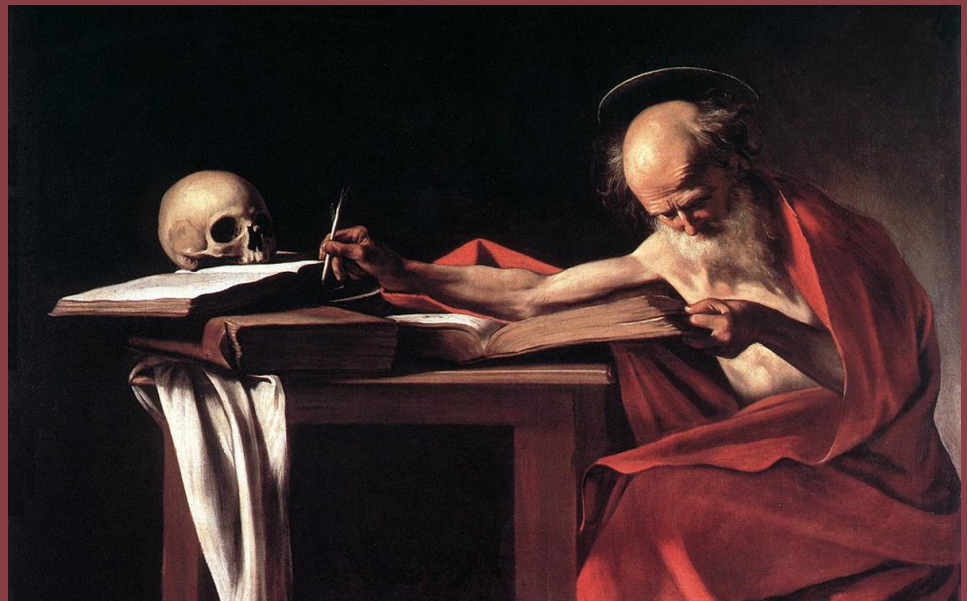
